## **RESOLUTION NO. 2023-12**

## AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION, REMEDIATION, AND DEMOLITION OF THE FORMER RELIABLE CASTINGS - COLERAIN AVENUE SITE

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Greater Cincinnati Development Authority (The "Port"), a body corporate and politic duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the State of Ohio, is authorized and empowered, by virtue of the laws of the State of Ohio, including, without limitation, Section 13 of Article VIII, Ohio Constitution, and Sections 4582.21 through 4582.71, Ohio Revised Code (the "Act") to, among other things, acquire interests in real property in furtherance of any "authorized purpose" under the Act; and

**WHEREAS**, The Port has the opportunity to purchase the properties formerly owned by Reliable Castings, and located at 1315 Arlington St., 3417 Colerain Ave., 3405-3409 Colerain Ave., 3411 Colerain Ave., and Colerain Avenue, in Camp Washington (the "Property") as part of The Port's Industrial Revitalization Strategy; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cincinnati anticipates approving capital funding to The Port through the Community Development Block Grant program in the amount of \$611,698.75 for the purpose of acquiring the Property; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio Department of Development has awarded to The Port through the Brownfield Remediation Program the amount of \$1,396,152.00 for the purpose of remediating, demolishing, and performing additional necessary site work on the Property in anticipation of future redevelopment; and

**WHEREAS**, pending satisfactory completion of due diligence, The Port desires to purchase the Property in order to remediate, demolish, and prepare the site for future redevelopment, all in furtherance of its authorized purposes;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of the Port of Greater Cincinnati Development Authority:

Section 1. This Board hereby authorizes the President/CEO of The Port to expend up to \$2,007,850.75 to acquire, remediate, demolish, and perform additional site work on the Property, pending satisfactory completion of due diligence.

Section 2. This Board further authorizes the President/CEO of The Port to contract with any development contractors, including but not limited to an affiliate of the seller of the Property, that are deemed in her professional judgment to be necessary and appropriate, without the need for public bidding or procurement procedures.

Section 3. This Board finds and determines that (a) the Property constitutes a "port authority facility" within the meaning of the Act and (b) the acquisition, furnishing, and equipping of the Property will support the "authorized purposes" of The Port, including but not limited to, retaining employment opportunities and enhancing, fostering, and aiding economic development in Hamilton County and the State of Ohio.

Section 3. This Board finds and determines that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were taken, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action were held in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption.
