The Reserve at 4th and Race formerly served as home to the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland. Now, the building is again a vital centerpiece of downtown Cincinnati's West Fourth Street Historic District. The Port Authority governed the use of a \$750,000 Clean Ohio Assistance Fund (COAF) grant and oversaw the environmental services work and asbestos abatement.
