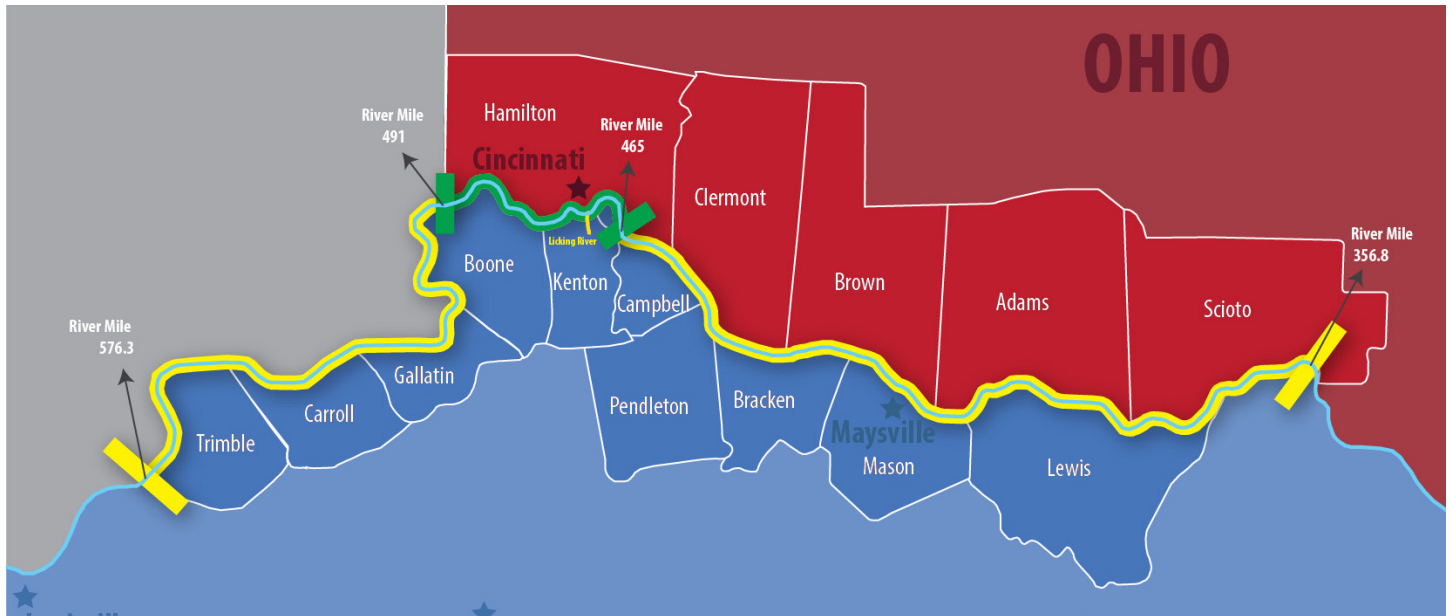


PORTS REDESIGNATION

2012 - PORTS OF CINCINNATI & N. KENTUCKY

In August 2012, the Port of Greater Cincinnati Development Authority and the Northern Kentucky Port Authority formally partnered to petition the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to re-designate the then-Port of Cincinnati's jurisdictional description from 26 miles to 226.5 miles. The port re-designation effort was approved in January 2015.
