US EPA brings Federal resources to environmental cleanup



August 29, the US Environmental Protection Agency announced the start of asbestos removal actions at the former Hudepohl Brewery site in Queensgate which has sat vacant for the past 30 years. The six-month project will clean up asbestos debris leftover from demolition undertaken by the previous owners of the structure. This partnership brings \$1.8 MM in federal funding to the redevelopment of this site.
